- A framework/approach for teaching expected behaviour
- Celebrating and focusing on the positive behaviour
- Tiered Interventions when behaviour happens


### WHY?

Behaviorally-based systems + an effective positive environment

= maximized learning for students

# The "Matrix"

#### CARING COPERATIVE RESPONSIBLE RESPECTFUL




- Expected behaviour for <u>ALL</u> areas of our school is taught to the students
- Common language for all staff and students at Leary F.A. through our "Matrix"
- Proactive rather than Reactive

## Student A.I.D.E forms

#### ASSISTANCE INTERVENTION DISCIPLINE EDUCATION

- Kids make mistakes
- Minor and Major behaviour
  - Consequences for repeated behaviour
  - Leveled for severety
- Communication
  - Sent home, phone call opportunity for discussion
- Planning for Prevention
  - SWIS Data

The emphasis is on the use of the most effective <u>and</u> most positive approach to addressing even the most severe problem behaviors.



## **Pawsitives**


#### **CATCHING THE POSITIVE BEHAVIOUR**

- For staff just as much as students
- Celebration of expected behaviour
