Safe Schools

The Chilliwack School District and F.G. Leary Fine Arts Elementary are committed to a safe and welcoming learning environment for our students, parents, and staff. To protect the teaching and learning environment and student privacy, all visitors, including parents, must report to the office during the school day (8:25-2:16). After reporting to the office, visitors must sign in and wear a **Volunteer Badge before proceeding in the school.** For the safety of our school environment, only the front doors of the school will be unlocked during the school day to ensure we are aware of all visitors to our school. In the mornings, we advise parents/guardians who drive or walk their children to school to use the

In the mornings, we advise parents/guardians who drive or walk their children to school to use the designated line up area. We have staff supervision at that location from (8:10-8:25) and those who arrive after 8:25 a.m. are required to access the school through the front doors. With that said, we greatly appreciate your efforts in ensuring that your children arrive to school on time.

At school dismissal time (2:16), all students will be dismissed out the doors at the back of the school leading to the black top area (except for Kindergarten. Parents/guardians are encouraged to set up a "meeting spot" with their child/ren.

We value every minute of instructional time for our students and our end of day procedures are valuable in setting our students up for success. If you arrive early, we ask that you wait outside until the dismissal bell and meet your child at your designated "meeting spot". If you need to help your child or want to talk to your child/ren's teacher, we ask you to please enter the building after the dismissal bell. We are asking you to do this because in order to protect the learning and privacy of students the hallways are an area that staff use to talk and teach students.

We thank you for your cooperation and for working with us in making FG Leary Fine Arts Elementary School a safe learning environment for our students.

Parent Advisory Council (PAC)

Every parent and guardian of a FG Leary student is automatically a member of the FG Leary PAC. We encourage you to get involved and help make a difference.

Inclement weather conditions such as freezing rain, significant snowfall or high wind can occur during the fall and winter months. In such conditions, decisions on the opening or closure of school district facilities are made by the Superintendent of Schools in consultation with management and supervisory staff who have checked first-hand on the driving conditions and general condition of buildings. While service to students and parents is a priority and schools will be kept open as much as is reasonably possible, student and staff safety is the primary consideration. In the event of extreme weather conditions, parents are urged to check the School District website www.sd33.bc.ca, tune into radio stations STAR FM 98.3, The Drive 89.5, or The Weather Network (cable channel 90, STAR Choice 398 or Bell Expressview 505) to receive up-to-date information on school closures and information on the buses. Reports will start after 6:00am and will be repeated often. The information broadcast is directly from the School District. The reports are confirmed and there is no need to call your school, the School District Office or the radio station. Students will be marked absent for the day, but such an absence will not affect a perfect attendance record. In the event that there is inclement weather but the school remains open, it is the parent's decision, based on their assessment of the relative safety of travel conditions, as to whether or not their children attend school.

Parking Lot Safety

We are encouraging a traffic pattern that should help with improving safety.

These are the important points to remember:

- * Give yourself time! Arrive by 8:15 and pickup at 2:25. The traffic volume is lower at these times.
- Students should be in the lineups on the basketball court in the morning, they will enter and leave through the north playground doors. Please do not use the main doors unless you are late.
- There is a **Drop Off** only lane next to the school. No Parking in this area at any time. **Never leave your vehicle unattended**.
- Never drop off or pickup your child in the drive thru lane!
- There is also a designated Bus area for Daycares right in front of the school. These vehicles must have a sign that is clearly visible to park in this area.
- * Parking is encouraged in the large parking lot or in the designated lane on the street. Obey all street signs and **do not park in handicap parking spots** unless you have a permit.
- * Be considerate and do not block parked cars!
- * School District #33 has adopted a no **idling** policy. If you need to wait please park in the parking lot and turn your car off
- We will be on supervision to help students and parents.
