Parking Lot Safety

We are encouraging a traffic pattern that should help with improving safety.

These are the important points to remember:

* Give yourself time! Arrive by 8:15 and pickup at 2:30. The traffic volume is lower at these times.
• Students should be in the lineups on the basketball court in the morning. They will enter and leave through the north playground doors. Please do not use the main doors unless you are late.

• There is a **Drop Off** only lane next to the school. No Parking in this area at any time. **Never leave your vehicle unattended**.

• Never drop off or pickup your child in the drive thru lane!

• There is also a designated Bus area for Daycares right in front of the school. These vehicles must have a sign that is clearly visible to park in this area.

* Be considerate and do not block parked cars!

* School District #33 has adopted a no **idling** policy. If you need to wait please park in the parking lot and turn your car off.
